# Cozumel Coast

When the Spanish arrived in Cozumel in the early 1500's they found plants and animals that could be found nowhere else on earth. The unique habitat literally rose from the ocean creating an isolated environment full of mangrove swamps that was home to monkeys, sea turtles, iguanas, and crocodiles. Many of the indigenous species can no longer be found here. Some, like the Cozumel Thrasher are on the verge of extinction. Visitors today come to explore the riches of a vanishing habitat and to discover some of the most colorful coral reefs in the world.
