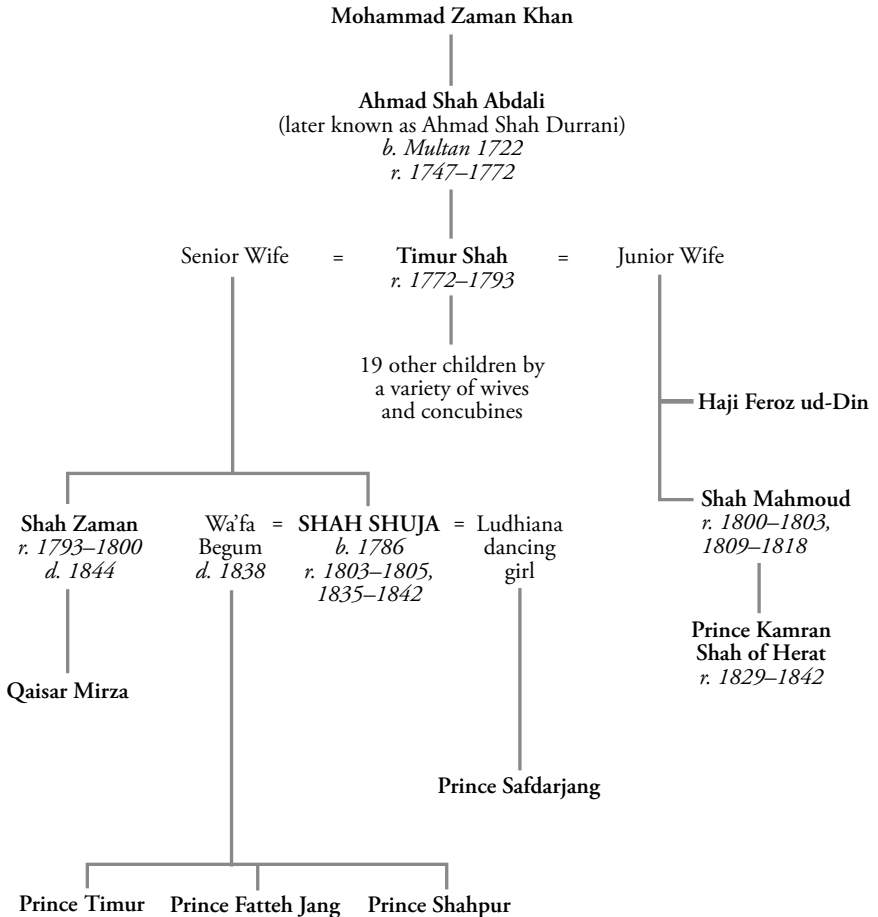
KABUL 1839-42
