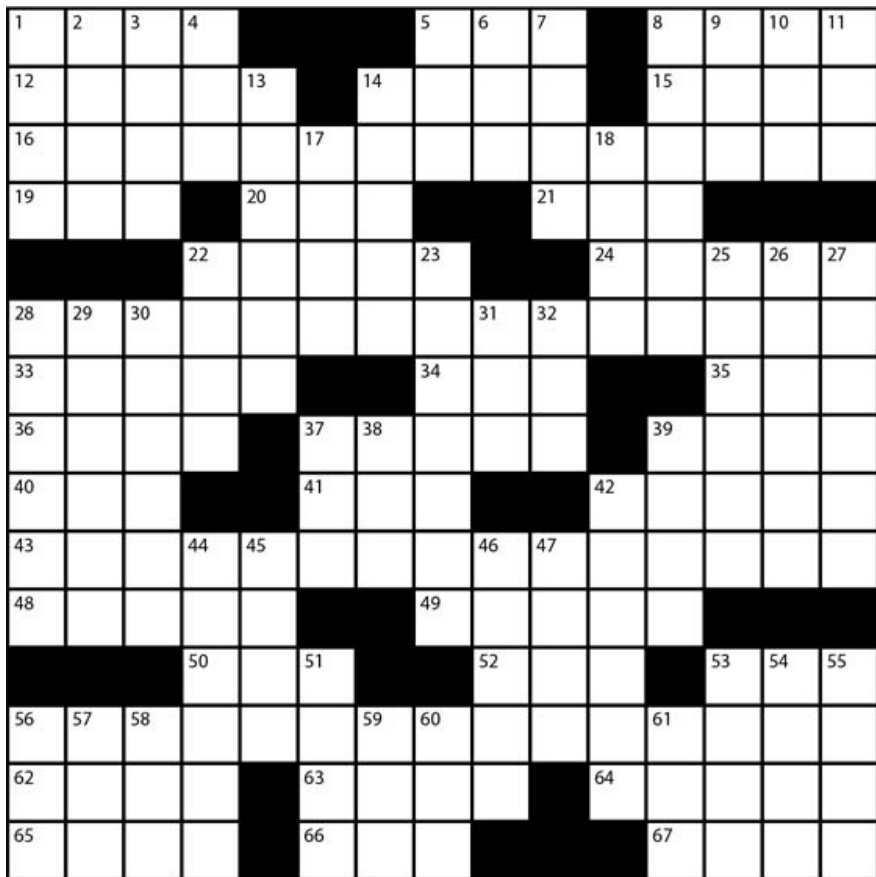

Hunter's Pudding

A HOLIDAY FAVORITE FROM THE VICTORIAN ERA

Stone and shred 3-DOWN rather small; chop 1 lb. of suet finely.

Pound 1/2 of 23-ACROSS, 6 of 54-ACROSS, and 2 of 58 ACROSS into powder.

Rub 1 lb. of stale bread crumbs until the lumps are well broken.

Cut 1/4 lb. of 18-ACROSS into thin strips.

Chop 1 lb. of currants.

Blend all these ingredients well ...

Add 1/2 lb. of sugar and 1 tbs. of flour:

*Beat 8 eggs to a virgorous froth; while beating, add 10 drops of 38-ACROSS and 10
drops of essence of lemon.*

Fold the egg mixture into the dry ingredients; mix and add 27-DOWN.

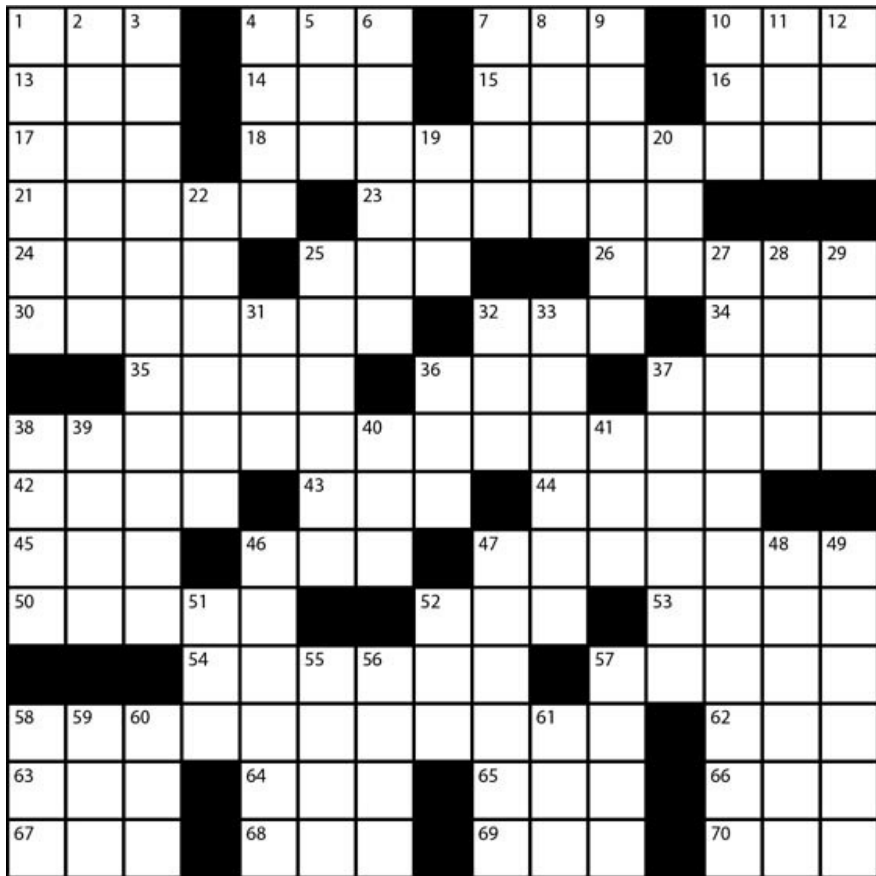
Tie the pudding firmly in a cloth.

Boil for 6 hours (7 or 8 would be better yet).

Serve with boiled custard, red currant jelly, or brandy sauce.

Sufficient for 9 or 10 persons
