CULTURAL INSIGHT

1. Christmas

Christmas in the Netherlands is celebrated on the 25th and 26th of December. The 25th is "first Christmas Day" and the 26th is called "second Christmas Day." Both are national holidays. Usually on the first Christmas Day families come together and enjoy an evening of a nice Christmas dinner and exchanging presents. The second Christmas Day is mostly spent outdoors. Visiting a Christmas market or taking a long walk are popular activities for the second Christmas Day.

2. Easter

On Easter in the Netherlands most shops are closed. On this day, most Dutch people will enjoy an Easter breakfast and relax.

3. Queen's Day

On this national holiday Dutch people celebrate the birthday of the Queen. There are a lot of traditional activities held, and every year the royal family visits a different city.

4. New Year's Day

On the first day of the New Year, many people go to the beach to take part in the New Year's dive. This tradition involves taking a dive into the icy cold sea water.

5. Liberation Day

Liberation Day has been celebrated every year since 1945. The day was declared to be a national holiday in 1990.

1. Ice-cream

2. Vla, a type of custard

Vla custard is a dairy product that is made of cooked milk and custard. It is served cold, and has the same texture as yoghurt, but has a sweet taste instead of sour. It is available in many flavors such as banana, vanilla, chocolate and strawberry.

3. Apple pie

Apple pie and coffee are a part of Dutch culture, and are served in almost all restaurants.

4. Advocaat, a Dutch liqueur

Advocaat is a traditional Dutch liqueur that is rich and creamy and made from eggs, sugar and brandy.

5. Pudding

Pudding is a sweet dessert which is popular in the Netherlands.

3. Cherry

There are two kinds of cherries in the Netherlands: sweet and sour. The sweet cherries are used for direct consumption, while the sour cherry is used to make jam or juice.

4. Banana

This popular fruit is used in various desserts. A famous one is the banana split.

5. Raspberry

Not only the fruits but also the leaves of the raspberry plant are used to make tea. The fruit is sweet and has a blue color. They are eaten fresh or are processed as jam.

CULTURAL INSIGHT

1. Tomato

The tomato is a popular vegetable and is used in various dishes and salads. The most delicious tomato in the Netherlands is the honey tomato.

2. Carrot

This vegetable got its distinctive orange color from the Dutch. In the 17th century the carrot was first brought from Iran to the Netherlands. It had a different color from its present orange, but the Dutch cross-bred it until they had a hybrid with the same orange colour as that of the Royal House of Orange-Nassau. After that the orange carrot spread out all over the rest of Europe.

3. Cauliflower

This common vegetable is grown in large quantities in the provinces of North-Holland and Friesland. They make a traditional dish when eaten together with potatoes and a meatball.

4. Onion

Onions have a long history in Europe. They can be found in many old traditional stories and famous paintings.

5. Pea

Peas are a popular vegetable usually served in a dish with baked potatoes and carrots.

CULTURAL INSIGHT

1. Stroopwaffle

This syrup waffle is made from two layers of baked batter with a caramel filling in the middle. Dutch people will sometimes put the stroopwafel on top of a hot cup of tea to make the syrup melt.

2. Licorice

This famous confectionery gets its flavor from the extract of the root of the licorice plant. The licorice has a strong taste and comes in all kinds of shapes. This original European candy comes in various souvenir packagings, so it's one of the top souvenir products to be sold in the Netherlands.

3. Marshmallow

Marshmallows are loved by Dutch people young and old, and are used in various ways, such as in a cup of hot chocolate milk or added to ice-cream.

4. Hopje

Hopje is an original Dutch sweet that has a light coffee and caramel flavor. The first hopje was made in the 18th century.

5. Chocolate

Dutch people love chocolate very much, and it comes in all kinds of forms. Chocolate arrived in the Netherlands for the first time in the 16th century and gained a lot of popularity. Today the most famous Dutch chocolate brands are Verkade, Droste and Van Houten.

1. Carnaval

This traditional Catholic holiday is celebrated three days before Ash Wednesday. Carnaval is celebrated from Sunday until Tuesday evening.

2. St. Martin's Day

This is celebrated on the 11th of November. Children go from door to door with their lanterns, sing songs, and in return hope to receive sweets or fruits.

3. Wooden shoes

The wooden shoe was not only used in the Netherlands but in many other countries in Europe during the Middle Ages. They were mainly worn by workers and farmers.

4. Bicycle

The bicycle is very popular in the Netherlands. There are actually more bicycles than there are people in this small country!

5. Herring

Dutch people eat herring raw by holding it by its tail, dipping it into small pieces of onions, and then eating it from the head.

3. Cow

The dairy cow can be seen everywhere in the Netherlands. The enormous production of milk leads to a variety of cheese and other dairy products.

4. Badger

During the 1980s the badger almost became extinct in the Netherlands. Thanks to tremendous efforts from the organisation Das and Boom, the badger is now no longer on the

list of endangered species. It does however still get the highest degree of protection and attention.

5. Sea eagle

After an absence of several centuries, the sea eagle is now successfully breeding again in the Netherlands. Since 2006 a sea eagle pair has returned to the country every year after migrating.

4. Dyke

A artificially constructed wall which regulates water levels. The earliest dike in Holland dates back to the 12th century. The English word "dike" derives from the Dutch word *dijk*.

5. Canal

A canal is a man-made watercourse, usually in the countryside, irrespective of whether or not it has streets along its banks. Many of these canals can be found in the city of Amsterdam and the bridges across them are lit up at night, giving the city a romantic look.

A lot of Dutch families own a caravan. During the summer holiday, such families will go on three week trips to a camping site in France, Spain or Italy. On national holidays they will take their caravan to one of the many camping areas that can be found in the Netherlands.

The Netherlands is a great fishing country, and it's one of the most popular outdoor activities. Because the Netherlands is rich in water resources, there are many quiet and relaxing places where you can enjoy fishing at its best.

5. Bicycle tour

The popularity of bike riding in the Netherlands is probably due to the fact that it is a 'flat' country. Bike bridges, bike tunnels and bike paths are part of the infrastructure. 4. Travel trailer

A caravan is towed behind a road vehicle so it can be brought to various destinations, usually camping sites.

5. Canal house

A canal house is a (usually old) house overseeing a canal. Because of the danger of flooding, the front door is sometimes higher up.

Autumn and winter can be very cold in the Netherlands, so after World War II, most newly-built houses were equipped with a central heating system. The most common central heating system in the Netherlands is a type that uses water-circulation.

2. Coffeemaker

On average, a Dutch person drinks 10 kilos of coffee a year. Therefore a coffee maker is found in every house. When Dutch people visit each other's houses, it's quite normal to ask if the visiting guest would like a nice cup of coffee.

3. Fruitbowl

A fruitbowl is found on all tables in the living rooms or kitchens of Dutch people. Steel, glass, tin or just a simple basket is used as material. Apples, bananas and oranges are the usual fruits found in them.

4. Fireplace

In old houses the fireplace was the only heat source. The original fireplaces were then replaced by central heating systems, and so these days the fireplace is only there for decorational use.

5. Cheese slicer

Cheese is eaten every day in the Netherlands, and so this product is definitely a great help and one that can't be missed in any kitchen. They come in many shapes and colors and make a great souvenir for tourists.

1. Poffer

This big white cap was part of the traditional fashion in the province of Brabant, popular from

1870 to 1940. It was worn by women on Sunday to church or during special occasions. These days you can only see the poffer at traditional folk events or in a museum.

2. Fisherman's hat

The fisherman's hat is is still worn these days by Dutch sailors or those who work on ferries. It is traditionally made from blue wool and has a decorative ribbon around it.

3. Plus four

The *pofbroek* is a kind of knickerbocker that is a bit longer than the classic style of knickerbocker. It was mainly worn by men and became fashionable during the late 1860s. It was associated with men who played golf.

4. Kraplap

The kraplap is a type of double bib, similar to the overcollar found in some German costumes. The kraplap is found in many Dutch costumes, and is often decorated.

5. Wooden shoes, clogs

Wooden shoes are a type of footwear made in part or completely from wood. During the Middle Ages they were worn by many people in different parts of Europe. These days in small traditional fishing towns you can still see some people wearing wooden shoes.

3. Piet Pieterszoon Hein

Piet Hein was a Dutch naval officer and folk hero during the Eighty Years' War. He became vice-admiral of the new Dutch West India Company in 1623. He is most known for his capture of a Spanish treasure fleet loaded with silver from their American colonies.

4. Antonie Philips van Leeuwenhoek

Antonie van Leeuwenhoek was a Dutch scientist and tradesman from Delft in the Netherlands during the 17th century. He is considered to be the first microbiologist and is known as the "the Father of Microbiology". He was the first to observe and describe single-celled organisms.

5. Rembrandt Harmenszoon van Rijn

Rembrandt was a Dutch painter and etcher. He is considered one of the greatest painters in European art history and the most important in Dutch history.
