



Glossary

Algerian War for Independence from France—conflict that took place in Algeria from 1954–1962.

Casbah—the old part of Algiers, named for the Turkish-built sixteenth-century fortress that dominated the quarter. It was also the headquarters for the FLN.

centre aéré—a recreational child-care center.

FLN—Front de Libération Nationale (National Liberation Front), socialist political party in Algeria. It was organized on November 1, 1954, from a merger of small political groups that sought independence for Algeria from France.

harki—an Algerian soldier who remained loyal to the French army and therefore fought against his fellow Algerians.

OAS—Organisation de l'Armée Secrète (Organization of the Secret Army), a French far-right nationalist militant and underground organization during the Algerian War whose goal was to prevent Algeria's independence.

pied-noir—a European living in Algeria.
