- Will mandate health coverage for children.
- Will help patients by improving disease management programs and increasing transparency in health costs.
- Will lower costs by increasing competition in the insurance and drug markets.

- Will overhaul appliance and other energy-efficiency standards with the goal of reducing building energy use by 25 to 50 percent.

### Promises, Promises . . .

### The ACCOUNTABLE Report Card

It is the job of politicians to make promises, but it is the job of the people who elect them to make sure they keep them. Presidential election seasons are the times in our politics when most promises are made. This was certainly the case in the run-up to the 2008 election, especially given the many crises our country continues to face.

That said, what follows are a series of easy-to-use charts that detail the promises made by President Barack Obama.

We hope these charts, in conjunction with the Frameworks for Assessment at the end of each chapter, will motivate all who read them to track the progress of the president's vision for our future.

Presidents alone do not shape our future. Congress and the courts can pass laws and hand down decisions that chip away at any president's promises. Nonetheless, citizens must always be prepared to hold the president accountable on what he (perhaps one day, she!) promised he'd fight for.

Never forget, we, the people, are *accountable* for making sure that promises made are promises kept.

#### **HEALTH**

#### Health Insurance

Without health insurance, my kids and I won't be able to afford the care we need. How will an Obama administration help us?

PROVIDE UNIVERSAL HEALTH INSURANCE. "And we need to finally pass universal health care so that every American has access to health insurance that they can afford, and our getting the preventive services that are the key to cutting health care costs. That's what I pledge to do in my first term as president." "I'll pass a universal health care bill that cuts a typical family's premiums by up to \$2,500. And mark my words—I will sign this bill by the end of my first term as president."

MAKE INSURANCE AVAILABLE TO ALL WHO SEEK TO PURCHASE IT. "If you are one of the 45 million Americans who don't have health insurance, you will have it after this plan becomes law. No one will be turned away because of a preexisting condition or illness. Everyone will be able to buy into a new health insurance plan that's similar to the one that every federal employee . . . currently has for themselves. It will cover all essential medical services, including preventive, maternity, disease management, and mental health care. And it will also include high standards for quality and efficiency."

OFFER SUBSIDIES FOR THE UNINSURED. "If you cannot afford this insurance, you will receive a subsidy to pay for it. If you have children, they will be covered. If you change jobs, your insurance will go with you. If you need to see a doctor, you will not have to wait in long lines for one."

SUPPORT THE ALREADY-INSURED. Under Obama's plan, "if you like your current health insurance, nothing changes, except your costs will go down by as much as \$2,500 per year."

EXPAND EXISTING PLANS. Obama will "expand eligibility for the SCHIP and Medicaid programs and ensure that these programs continue to serve their critical safety-net function."

FOCUS ON PREVENTION. "Under my plan, we'll make sure insurance companies cover evidence-based, preventive care services—weight loss programs, smoking-cessation programs, and other efforts—to help people avoid costly, debilitating health problems in the first place."

ESTABLISH A NATIONAL EXCHANGE. "Establish a National Health Insurance Exchange with a range of private insurance options as well as a new public plan based on benefits available to members of Congress that will allow individuals and small businesses to buy affordable health coverage." "The Exchange will feature comprehensive benefits; affordable premiums, co-pays and deductibles, simplified paperwork, easy enrollment, and portability."

MANDATE PAYROLL CONTRIBUTIONS. "Make employer contributions more fair by requiring large employers that do not offer coverage or make a meaningful contribution to the cost of quality health coverage for their employees to contribute a percentage of payroll toward the costs of their employees' health care."

MAKE CHILD COVERAGE MANDATORY. Obama "will require that all children have health care coverage."

SUPPORT MALPRACTICE INSURANCE. Obama will "strengthen antitrust laws to prevent insurers from overcharging physicians for their malpractice insurance."

#### Catastrophic Illness

My Mom is more than sick—she has a chronic, terminal illness. How will President Obama help her pay the bills?

PAY FOR WORST ILLNESSES. "[W]e'll reduce costs for businesses and their workers by picking up the tab for some of the most expensive illnesses. Right now, the five percent of patients with the most serious illnesses like cancer and heart disease account for nearly fifty percent of health care costs. Insurance companies devote the lion's share of their expenses to these patients, and then pass the cost on to the rest of us in the form of higher premiums. Under my plan, the federal government will pay for part of these catastrophic cases, which means that your premiums will go down."

REFORM BANKRUPTCY LAWS TO PROTECT FAMILIES FACING A MEDICAL CRISIS. "We have to release people who are in bankruptcy as a consequence of health care. We've got to give them a break." Obama "will create an exemption in bankruptcy law for individuals who can prove they filed for bankruptcy because of medical expenses. This exemption will create a process that forgives the debt and lets the individuals get back on their feet."

END CHERRY-PICKING. "Insurance companies spend \$50 billion a year on elaborate efforts to cherry-pick the healthiest patients and avoid covering everyone else. I intend to save them a whole lot of time and money by putting an end to this practice once and for all."

How will an Obama administration advance medical science through research?

LIFT BAN ON STEM CELL RESEARCH. "I will lift the current administration's ban on federal funding of research on embryonic stem-cell lines created after 9 August 2001 through executive order, and I will ensure that all research on stem cells is conducted ethically and with rigorous oversight."

SUPPORT STEM CELL RESEARCH ENHANCEMENT. "I am a proud supporter of the Stem Cell Research Enhancement Act. The president was wrong to veto it, and I will make sure that it is finally signed into law when I'm president."

FUND DISEASE MANAGEMENT RESEARCH. "I will encourage the development of biological markers of disease that might simplify the evaluation of new therapies, the use of genetic information to select patients most likely to benefit from new treatments, and the multidisciplinary efforts that are now possible at many research centers. In addition, I will support increased attention to research that focuses on prevention, early detection, and improved management of disease."

#### Global Public Health

I hear a lot about the new "globalized economy," but I get the sense that health issues, too, know no borders. How will President Obama protect our nation's health, in the context of global health?

HELP ELIMINATE AIDS. Obama pledged to "increase spending on global HIV/ AIDS to \$50 billion between 2009 and 2013, while at the same time increasing overall foreign assistance spending to \$50 billion annually."

FIGHT AGAINST DISEASE USED AS A WEAPON. "I will work with the international community to make any use of disease as a weapon declared a crime against humanity."

COLLABORATE IN GLOBAL RESEARCH. "I will also encourage research collaboration in areas where multinational investments are essential, such as medical research on malaria and other diseases. These programs will be fully funded as a part of my strong commitment to double basic research budgets."

#### **Lowering Costs**

PERMIT GENERIC IMPORTS. Obama promised to "lower drug costs by allowing the importation of safe medicines from other developed countries, increasing the use of generic drugs in public programs, and taking on drug companies that block cheaper generic medicines from the market."

CONVERT PAPER RECORDS TO ELECTRONIC RECORDS. Obama will "invest \$10 billion a year over the next five years to move the U.S. health care system to broad adoption of standards-based electronic health information systems, including electronic health records."

REQUIRE THAT PLANS USE PROVEN METHODS. Obama will "require that plans that participate in the new public plan, Medicare, or the Federal Employees Health Benefits Program (FEHBP) utilize proven disease management programs. This will improve quality of care and lower costs as well."

ALLOW DRUG PRICE NEGOTIATION. Obama will "repeal the ban on direct negotiation with drug companies and use the resulting savings, which could be as high as \$30 billion, to further invest in improving health care coverage and quality."

#### **Informing Patients**

While I'm no medical expert, I believe that knowledge is power. How will an Obama administration encourage transparency among health care providers?

ESTABLISH INSTITUTE ON COMPARATIVE EFFECTIVENESS. Obama will "establish an independent institute to guide reviews and research on comparative effectiveness, so that Americans and their doctors will have accurate and objective information to make the best decisions for their health and well-being."

PUBLICIZE HEALTH DATA. Obama will "require hospitals to collect and report health care cost and quality data. We'll provide the public with information about preventable medical errors, nurse-to-patient ratios, and hospital-acquired infections." "Health plans will be required to disclose the percentage of premiums that actually goes to paying for patient care as opposed to administrative costs."

PUBLICIZE DISPARITY DATA. Obama will "challenge the medical system to eliminate inequities in health care by requiring hospitals and health plans to collect, analyze, and report health care quality for disparity populations and holding them accountable for any differences found: diversifying the workforce to ensure culturally effective care . . . and supporting and expanding the capacity of safetynet institutions, which provide a disproportionate amount of care for underserved populations with inadequate funding and technical resources."

PUBLICIZE MEDICAL ERRORS. Obama "will require providers to report preventable medical errors and support hospital and physician practice improvement to prevent future errors."

SHARE PROFITS. Obama will "prevent companies from abusing their monopoly power through unjustified price increases." In markets where the insurance business is not competitive, his plan will "force insurers to pay out a reasonable share of their premiums for patient care instead of keeping exorbitant amounts for profits and administration."

## **Supporting Parents**

President Obama has outlined his administration's support for schools and students. What about parents?

CREATE PARENTS' REPORT CARD. "I'll create a parents' report card that will show you whether your kid is on the path to college."

EXPAND PAID MEDICAL LEAVE. "I'll expand the Family Medical Leave Act to include . . . millions more workers, to let parents participate in school activities with their kids. . . . [W]e'll . . . put federal support behind state efforts to provide paid . . . [I]eave."

OFFER BETTER CHILD CARE. Obama will "provide affordable and high-quality child care to ease the burden on working families." The Child Care Development Block Grant (CCDBG) program provides critical support to low-income families to pay for child care. Obama "will reverse this policy and ensure that CCDBG remains adequately funded every year." He will also "double the resources for quality within CCDBG to support efforts such as developing quality rating systems for child care that reflect higher standards and supports for teacher training and professional development."

EXPAND HOME VISITING PROGRAMS. Obama will "expand . . . home visiting programs to all low-income, first-time mothers, [programs that have empirically] improved women's prenatal health, . . . [reduced] childhood injuries, . . . increased maternal employment, and increased children's school readiness. The . . . plan will assist . . . 570,000 first-time mothers each year."

PRESENT ANNUAL REPORT. Obama will "make federal education programs more performance-based and report results to the public and Congress at least once a year."

## Affording College

How will an Obama administration help me pay for college?

OFFER TAX CREDIT: \$4K FOR 100 HOURS. "I want to give tax breaks to young people, in the form of an annual \$4,000 tax credit" that will be "available . . . at the time of enrollment by using prior year's tax data to deliver the credit at the time that tuition is due." "Recipients of this credit will be required to conduct 100 hours of public service a year."

PROVIDE 40,000 TEACHING SERVICE SCHOLARSHIPS: \$25K EACH. These scholarships "cover four years of undergraduate or two years of graduate teacher education . . . for those who are willing to teach in a high-need field or location for at least four years."

FUND PELL GRANTS. Obama will "ensure that the award keeps pace with the rising cost of college tuition."

FUND VETERANS. "[F]or those who serve in our military, we'll cover all of your tuition with an even more generous 21st Century GI Bill."

ELIMINATE FAFSA FORMS. Obama will "streamline the financial aid process by eliminating the current federal financial aid application [FAFSA—Free Application for Federal Student Aid] and enabling families to apply simply by checking a box on their tax form, authorizing their tax information to be used, and eliminating the need for a separate application."

ELIMINATE FFEL PROGRAM. Obama will "eliminate the FFEL [Federal Family Education Loan] program that provides wasteful subsidies to banks and mandate that all federal student loans be provided through the direct loan program."

CONSOLIDATE DIRECT LOAN PROGRAM. "It's really important that we revamp our college loan programs to free up more money for students. The direct loan program works extremely well—there doesn't appear to be a need for these student loan programs to be managed through banks and other private lenders. If we consolidate programs under the Direct Loan program, we would save \$4.5 billion."

## **Empowering Teachers**

How will President Obama help teachers help students?

MANDATE ACCREDITATION. Obama will "require professional accreditation of all programs preparing teachers, with a focus on evidence regarding how well teachers are prepared."

TRACK TEACHERS' PROGRESS. "Colleges of education and alternative licensure programs will track their graduates' entry and retention in teaching and their contributions to growth in student learning."

OFFER CHALLENGE GRANTS. "Challenge grants will encourage the adoption of successful practices across the entire enterprise of teacher preparation."

REFORM TEACHER EDUCATION: \$100 MILLION. Obama will "provide \$100 million to stimulate teacher education reforms built on school-university partnerships."

OFFER BONUSES. "[W]e've got to provide bonuses for certain areas like math and science instruction where we just don't have enough teachers as well as bonuses for teachers who are willing to teach in tough settings."

EXPAND TEACHER RESIDENCY PROGRAMS. Obama will expand the number of Teacher Residency Programs, especially in math and science, by providing funding for 200 new programs serving an average of 150 candidates each year. The plan will annually "supply 30,000 exceptionally well-prepared recruits to high-need schools to provide long-term commitment and leadership in these districts."

SUPPORT CAREER LADDER INITIATIVE. "[W]e've got to have career ladders for teachers, so that if they become nationally board-certified, if they're learning new subject matter, if they are serving as a master teacher to help younger teachers, you know, that they get increased pay for those things that they're doing." The program "provide[s] federal resources to states and districts to leverage state efforts to create strong mentoring that supports beginning teachers. It will provide \$1 billion in funding for grants to create mentoring programs and reward veteran teachers for becoming mentors."

DEVELOP CLASSROOM CORPS. Obama will establish a "Classroom Corps to help teachers and students, with a priority placed on high-need and underserved schools. The Corps will enlist retired or mid-career engineers and scientists to provide support for math and science teachers in the form of mentoring, student tutoring, curriculum development, and technology support. It will recruit neighborhood civic, business, and faith leaders to offer after-school programs and community service opportunities."

PROVIDE TEACHING SERVICE SCHOLARSHIPS. Obama will "create substantial, sustained Teaching Service Scholarships that completely cover training costs in high-quality teacher preparation or alternative certification programs . . . for those who are willing to teach in a high-need field or location for at least four years. The scholarships will cover four years of undergraduate or two years of graduate teacher education, including programs for mid-career recruits in exchange for teaching for at least four years in a high-need field or location."

## Strengthening Our K-12 Schools

How will President Obama ensure that all children have access to an excellent, 21st-century education?

EXTEND LEARNING TIME. Longer school days or longer school years can help provide additional learning time for students to close the achievement gap. Obama will "create a \$200 million grant program for states and districts that want to provide additional learning time for students in need."

EXPAND SUMMER PROGRAMS. Obama called for expanding summer programs "so young people have a place to do homework and are not on the street getting into trouble."

DOUBLE THE NUMBER OF CHARTER SCHOOLS. "[A]s president, I'll double the funding for responsible charter schools."

CREATE INNOVATIVE SCHOOLS FUND. Obama will "create an Innovative Schools Fund to provide funds to states and school districts to implement plans to create a 'portfolio' of successful public school types, including charters, nonprofit schools, Montessori schools, career academies, and theme-focused schools."

FOSTER COLLABORATION. Obama will "establish a competitive grant process open to existing or proposed public/private partnerships or entities that are pursuing evidence-based models that work—such as Diploma Plus or Teacher Advisor programs. These grants will decrease the dropout rate by increasing the capacity of state and district leaders as well as outside leaders—foundations, politicians, entrepreneurs, and community leaders—to collaborate on improving graduation rates."

BE WARY OF VOUCHERS. "What I do oppose is using public money for private school vouchers. We need to focus on fixing and improving our public schools, not throwing our hands up and walking away from them."

IMPROVE STEM EDUCATION. "I will support research to understand the strategies and mechanisms that bring lasting improvements to STEM [Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics] education and ensure that promising practices are widely shared. This includes encouraging the development of cutting-edge STEM instructional materials and technologies, and working with educators to ensure that assessments measure the range of knowledge and skills needed for the 21st century. I will bring coherency to STEM education by increasing coordination of federal STEM education programs and facilitating cooperation among state efforts."

DOUBLE R&D FUNDING. Obama promised to "double our investment in early education and educational R&D [Research and Development]" by the end of his first term in office. "Part of this investment will involve an R&D program for improving science education. This new program will build knowledge about strategies and mechanisms that can bring lasting improvements to science and math and technology education."

INVEST IN INTERVENTION STRATEGIES. Obama will address the dropout crisis by pushing for his legislation "to provide funding to school districts to invest in intervention strategies in middle school—strategies such as personal academic plans, teaching teams, parent involvement, mentoring, intensive reading and math instruction, and extended learning time."

DOUBLE AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS. Obama will "double funding for the main federal support for after-school programs—the 21st Century Learning Centers program—to serve one million more children."

SUPPORT COLLEGE READINESS: AP CLASSES. Obama will "create a national 'Make College A Reality' initiative that has a bold goal to increase students taking AP or college-level classes nationwide [to] 50 percent by 2016, and will build on [my] bipartisan proposal in the U.S. Senate to provide grants for students seeking college-level credit at community colleges if their school does not provide those resources." "I'm calling for the creation of innovative—an Innovative Schools Fund. This fund will invest in schools like the Austin Polytechnical Institute, which is located in a part of Chicago that's been hard hit by the decline in manufacturing over the past few decades. . . . That's the kind of model we'll replicate across the country when I'm President of the United States."

INVEST IN EARLY ASSESSMENT. Obama will "provide \$25 million annually in matching funds for states to develop Early Assessment Programs. These funds will also promote state efforts to raise awareness about the availability of federal and state financial aid programs. . . . This program will increase college readiness and is voluntary."

INVEST IN TECHNOLOGY. Obama will "build on existing federal education technology programs and create a \$500 million matching fund to ensure technology is fully integrated throughout schools." He will also "create new technology-based curricula with leaders in the technology industry so schools can create courses around developing high-demand technology skills and working on authentic projects."

REFORM NCLB. Obama pledged to "fix the failures of No Child Left Behind [NCLB] by providing the funding that was promised." He will "reform NCLB, which starts by funding the law . . . [to] improve the assessments used to track student progress to measure readiness for college and the workplace, and improve student learning in a timely, individualized manner." He will also "improve NCLB's accountability system so that we are supporting schools that need improvement, rather than punishing them."

## Contributing to a College Education

How will President Obama support colleges?

ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY COLLEGE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM. Obama will "create a Community College Partnership Program to strengthen community colleges by providing grants to (a) conduct more thorough analysis of the types of skills and technical education that are in high demand from students and local industry; (b) implement new associate of arts degree programs that cater to emerging industry and technical career demands; and (c) reward those institutions that graduate more students and also increase their numbers of transfer students to four-year institutions."

OFFER NOT JUST WORK-STUDY, BUT *SERVE*-STUDY. Obama "believe[s] we need to move now to raise the service threshold to 25 percent so that more students can afford to engage in public service. This will help more than 200,000 college students a year complete part-time public service while they are in school. [I] will work to help colleges and universities reach the goal of 50 percent in serve-study."

SUPPORT THE ROTC. Presidential debate moderator Tim Russert: "Senator Obama . . . [w]ill you vigorously enforce a statute which says colleges must allow military recruiters on campus and provide ROTC programs?" Senator Obama: "Yes."

## Agribusiness

PROTECT FAMILY FARMERS. Obama will "implement a \$250,000 payment limitation so that we help family farmers—not large corporate agribusiness. [I] will close the loopholes that allow mega farms to get around the limits by subdividing their operations into multiple paper corporations."

CAP FARM SUBSIDIES. Obama will "cap mega farm subsidies so that we don't have continued concentration of agriculture in the hands of a few large agribusiness interests"

### **RURAL AREAS**

## **Rural Economic Development**

How will an Obama administration grow the rural economy?

SUPPORT SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT. Obama will "provide capital for farmers to create value-added enterprises, like cooperative marketing initiatives and farmer-owned processing plants. [I] also will establish a small business and micro-enterprise initiative for rural America."

CONNECT RURAL AMERICA. Obama will "ensure that rural Americans have access to a modern communications infrastructure. [I] will modernize an FCC program that supports rural phone service so that it promotes affordable broadband coverage across rural America as well."

UPGRADE RURAL INFRASTRUCTURE. Obama will "invest in the core infrastructure, roads, bridges, locks, dams, water systems, and essential air service that rural communities need."

## Reducing Crack or Cocaine Abuse

How will an Obama administration rectify the sentencing disparities between crack and cocaine?

ELIMINATE CRACK/COCAINE SENTENCING DISPARITY. Obama "believes the disparity between sentencing crack and powder-based cocaine is wrong and should be completely eliminated" and "will work in a bipartisan way to eliminate these disparities."

RECONSIDER SENTENCING FOR FIRST-TIME OFFENDERS. Obama "will also repeal the mandatory minimum sentence for first-time offenders convicted of simple possession of crack, as crack is the only drug that a nonviolent first-time offender can receive a mandatory minimum sentence for possessing."

## **Ending Drug Abuse**

Will President Obama regard drug abuse as a crime or an illness?

OFFER REHAB FOR FIRST-TIME OFFENDERS. "And we will give first-time, nonviolent drug offenders a chance to serve their sentence, where appropriate, in the type of drug rehabilitation programs that have proven to work better than a prison term in changing bad behavior. So let's reform this system. Let's do what's smart. Let's do what's just."

EXPAND DRUG COURTS. Obama will "replicate [drug courts] within the federal criminal justice system by signing a law that would authorize federal magistrates to preside over drug courts and federal probation officers to oversee the offenders' compliance with drug treatment programs."

FIGHT METHAMPHETAMINE. "As president, I will continue the fight to rid our communities of meth and offer support to help addicts heal and to reduce the demand for the drug. I will work to cut off drug lab supplies by restricting global imports of precursor chemicals, and I will take on the Mexican drug cartels in partnership with Mexico and other nations in the region."

PROMOTE ANTIDRUG HEMISPHERIC PACT. "I will direct my attorney general and homeland security secretary to meet with their Latin American and Caribbean counterparts in the first year of my presidency to produce a regional strategy to combat drug trafficking, domestic and transnational gang activity, and organized crime. A hemispheric pact on security, crime, and drugs will permit the United States, Latin America, and the Caribbean to advance serious and measurable drug demand reduction goals, while fostering cooperation on intelligence and investigating criminal activity."

PROMOTE ANTICORRUPTION, POLICE REFORM. "The United States will also work to strengthen civilian law enforcement and judicial institutions in the region by promoting anticorruption safeguards and police reform."

SUPPORT CROSS-BORDER AGREEMENTS. "I will . . . support the efforts of our border states to foster cooperation and constructive engagement with the region. . . . The . . . partnership[s]—based on information sharing, technical assistance, and training—provide an excellent model for regional cooperation on security issues. An Obama and Biden administration will support these initiatives and will work to integrate these efforts into the region's coordinated security pact."

FUND BYRNE-JAG PROGRAM. "As president, I will restore funding to this critical program." "Funding the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (Byrne-JAG) Program is essential to avoid law enforcement layoffs and cuts to hundreds of antidrug and antigang efforts across the country. . . . Byrne-JAG also funds prevention and drug treatment programs that are critical to reducing the U.S. demand for drugs."

ADVOCATE FOR ADDITIONAL REFORM EFFORTS. "I would . . . ensure that Congress robustly funds prevention and treatment programs like the Second Chance Act, Drug Courts, and the Drug Free Communities Support Program. . . . I will continue to support (and, in the case of drug courts, expand) these programs as president."

BAR MEDICAL MARIJUANA RAIDS. "I would not have the Justice Department prosecuting and raiding medical marijuana users. It's not a good use of our resources."

FORGIVE LOANS. "We'll recruit more public defenders to the profession by forgiving college and law school loans." "[We] will work to improve the quality of our nation's public defenders by creating loan-forgiveness programs for law students who enter this field."

# **Ending Racial Profiling**

I've been stopped driving while black, shopping while black—and seemingly breathing while black! What will an Obama administration do to halt this unfair practice?

BAN RACIAL PROFILING. As president, Obama will "continue his decades-long fight against racial profiling and sign legislation that will ban the practice of racial profiling by federal law enforcement agencies and provide federal funding to state and local police departments if they adopt policies to prohibit the practice."

COORDINATE WITH CIVIL RIGHTS DIVISION. "We know that in our criminal justice system, African Americans and whites, for the same crime, are arrested at very different rates, are convicted at very different rates, receive very different sentences . . . [t]hat is something that we have to talk about. But that's a substantive issue and it has to do with how do we pursue racial justice. If I am president, I will have a civil rights division that is working with local law enforcement so that they are enforcing laws fairly and justly."

## **Fighting Hate Crimes**

EXPAND HATE CRIMES LEGISLATION. Obama "will strengthen federal hate crimes legislation [and] expand hate crimes protection by passing the Matthew Shepard Act [named for the gay Wyoming student murdered in 1998]."

PRIORITIZE PROSECUTION OF HATE CRIME. "As president, [I] will ensure that the Criminal Section of the Civil Rights Division makes hate crime a priority."

# **Supporting Ex-Offenders**

How will an Obama administration prepare convicts to reenter society as rehabilitated, productive citizens?

PROVIDE JOB TRAINING. "[W]e'll provide job training for ex-offenders [so that] . . . they don't return to a life of crime."

CREATE JOBS. Obama will "create a prison-to-work incentive program, modeled on the Welfare-to-Work Partnership, to create ties with employers, third-party agencies that provide training and support services to ex-offenders, and to improve ex-offender employment and job retention rates."

REDUCE INSTITUTIONAL BARRIERS. Obama will "reduce bureaucratic barriers at state correctional systems that prevent former inmates from finding . . . employment."

FUND TRANSITIONAL WORK. "I will increase funding for transitional jobs and career pathways programs, and I'll provide greater supports for ex-offenders and their families."

FUND COUNSELING. Obama "will provide . . . substance abuse and mental health counseling to ex-offenders so that they are successfully reintegrated into society."

## Reducing Gun Violence

How will President Obama get guns out of our neighborhoods?

SUPPORT GUN TRACEABILITY. Obama will "repeal the Tiahrt Amendment, which restricts the ability of local law enforcement to access important gun trace information, and give police officers across the nation the tools they need to solve gun crimes and fight the illegal arms trade."

CLOSE LOOPHOLES. Obama "support[s] closing the gun show loophole." He believes local communities can "take those illegal handguns off the streets . . . and crack down on the various loopholes that exist in terms of background checks for children [and] the mentally ill."

MAKE ASSAULT WEAPONS BAN PERMANENT. Obama also supports "making the expired federal Assault Weapons Ban permanent, as such weapons belong on foreign battlefields and not on our streets."

MAKE GUNS CHILDPROOF. Obama supports "making guns in this country childproof."

ENFORCE EXISTING GUN LAWS. "We've got to enforce the gun laws that are on the books. We've got to make sure that unscrupulous gun dealers aren't loading up vans and dumping guns in our communities, because we know they're not made in our communities."

#### Miscellaneous

HELP ESTABLISH NCCIPS. Obama "fully support[s] the provision establishing a National Commission on Crime Intervention and Prevention Strategies (NCCIPS). . . . [It] will investigate approaches that are successful and help state and local law enforcement implement these effective strategies to fight and prevent crime. [It] will also tackle the new 21st-century crime and homeland security challenges the country faces."

END THE DANGEROUS CYCLE OF YOUTH VIOLENCE. As president, Obama will "support innovative local programs such as the CeaseFire program in Chicago that have been proven to work. Such programs implement a comprehensive public health approach that implements a community-based strategy to prevent youth violence. [I] will also double funding for federal after-school programs and invest in 20 Promise Neighborhoods across the country to ensure that urban youth have meaningful opportunities to succeed."

## **COPS Program**

Obama is "committed to fully funding the COPS [Community Oriented Policing Services] program to combat crime and help address police brutality and accountability issues in local communities. [In addition to putting 50,000 officers on the street, it] . . . provides local law enforcement funding for:

- hiring and training law enforcement officers;
- procuring equipment and support systems;
- paying officers to perform intelligence, anti-terror, or homeland security duties; and
- developing new technologies, including inter-operable communications and forensic technology."

INVEST IN COMMUNITY POLICING. "[W]e must stand for more than force; we must support the rule of law from the bottom up. That means more investments in prevention and prosecutors; in community policing and an independent judiciary."

CREATE "COPS FOR KATRINA." "[I]nstead of unsafe streets and shocking crimes, we will help New Orleans rebuild its criminal justice system. We'll start a new 'COPS for Katrina' program to put more resources into community policing, so that heroic officers . . . have more support."

### Carbon

What are President Obama's positions on carbon?

IMPOSE CARBON TAXES. "I believe that, depending on how it is designed, a carbon tax accomplishes much of the same thing that a cap-and-trade program accomplishes. . . . So as I roll out my proposals for a cap-and-trade system, I will price permits so that [they have] much of the same effect as a carbon tax."

FIGHT FOR LCFS. "I believe I am the only candidate who has proposed a National Low Carbon Fuel Standard [LCFS].... My LCFS provides a way for us to better understand the impacts of an advanced biofuels industry on the environment, so that as we move forward on cellulosics and other domestic fuels, we do so responsibly." "The standard requires fuels suppliers in 2010 to begin to reduce the carbon of their fuel by 5 percent within five years and 10 percent within 10 years."

### **Emissions**

How will an Obama administration keep greenhouse gas emissions under control?

REDUCE GREENHOUSE GASES. Obama has committed to "setting a goal of an 80 percent reduction in greenhouse gas emissions" . . . "below 1990 levels" . . . by 2050. "I will start reducing emissions immediately by establishing strong annual reduction targets with an intermediate goal of reducing emissions to 1990 levels by 2020."

MAKE POLLUTERS PAY. "All polluters will have to pay based on the amount of pollution they release into the sky. . . . [N]o business will be allowed to emit any greenhouse gases for free."

ENFORCE CAP AND TRADE. "My cap-and-trade system will require all pollution credits to be auctioned [100 percent of them]." "A small portion of the receipts generated by auctioning allowances (\$15 billion per year) will be used to support the development of clean energy and energy efficiency. All remaining receipts will be used for rebates and other transition relief to ensure that families and communities are not adversely impacted by the transition to a new energy, low-carbon economy."

SUPPORT CLIMATE SCIENCE. "I will fully support scientific efforts to understand climate change and [its] effects. . . . I will depoliticize climate science in the federal government and ensure that our policymakers rely on the best scientifically based evidence available. I will also expand on existing federal efforts to examine climate science, ensure that there is greater cooperation across the relevant federal agencies that already analyze aspects of climate science, and seek to bolster U.S. engagement in international climate science initiatives."

ACHIEVE CARBON NEUTRALITY BY 2030. Obama will "establish a goal of making all new buildings carbon neutral, or produce zero emissions, by 2030."

ENGAGE AGAIN WITH THE UNFCC. Obama will "re-engage with the U.N. Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCC), the main international forum dedicated to addressing the climate problem."

CONVENE EMITTING NATIONS. Obama will "invigorate the Major Economies (MEM) effort and bring all the major emitting nations together to develop effective emissions reduction efforts."

#### Collaboration

Energy problems are global, and we'll need an international team to combat them. How will President Obama ensure that when it comes to the environment, the United States doesn't go it alone?

CREATE GLOBAL ENERGY FORUM. "I will . . . engage China and India in global climate-change reduction efforts, and I will create a 'global energy forum'— [that] will include the world's highest emitters . . . to apply pressure to developed and developing nations alike to meaningfully reduce their carbon emissions. I will also re-engage the United States with the post-Kyoto international climate negotiations to restore U.S. leadership and pressure on the rest of the world to take similar steps to combat this truly global problem."

WORK WITH REPUBLICANS—AND EVERYBODY ELSE. "From the moment I take office as president, I will call together scientists and entrepreneurs; heads of industry and labor; Democrats, Republicans, and Americans from all walks of life to help develop and deploy the next generation of energy that will allow us to build the next generation's economy."

INFORM THE PUBLIC. "I will report to the American people every year on the State of Our Energy Future and let you know the progress we've made toward an 80 percent emissions reduction by 2050, toward replacing over a third of our oil consumption by 2030, and toward improving our energy efficiency 50 percent by 2030."

## Investing in New Technologies

How will an Obama administration keep us on the cutting edge of environmentally protective technologies?

INVEST \$150 BILLION IN CLEAN ENERGY R&D. "I've talked about spending \$150 billion over 10 years in an Apollo Project, a Manhattan Project to create the alternative energy strategies" that "will generate five million new jobs that pay well and can't ever be outsourced." "This research will cover:

- Basic research to develop alternative fuels and chemicals;
- Equipment and designs that can greatly reduce energy use in residential and commercial buildings—both new and existing;
- New vehicle technologies capable of significantly reducing our oil consumption;
- Advanced energy storage and transmission that would greatly help the economies of new electric-generating technologies and plug-in hybrids;
- Technologies for capturing and sequestering greenhouse gases produced by coal plants; and
- A new generation of nuclear electric technologies that address cost, safety, waste disposal, and proliferation risks."

LAUNCH VENTURE CAPITAL FUND. "I will launch a Clean Technologies Venture Capital Fund that will provide \$10 billion a year for five years to get the most promising clean energy technologies off the ground. This venture capital fund will get new technologies from the lab to the marketplace so that in the next few years, the American economy can benefit from America's innovations."

PRIORITIZE BROAD ENERGY MIX. "We have to have a broad energy mix, and I as president intend to make this one of my number-one domestic priorities and to put in the resources needed in order to make it happen."

## **Electricity**

How will President Obama limit our reliance on electricity?

REDUCE DEMAND BY 2020. Obama will "set an aggressive energy efficiency goal—to reduce electricity demand 15 percent from projected levels by 2020."

INCREASE RENEWABLE SOURCES BY 2025. "Ensure 10 percent of our electricity comes from renewable sources by 2012, and 25 percent by 2025."

## Renewable Energy

So many of us drive cars to work every day. How will an Obama administration ensure that not only his White House, but our America, uses fuel efficiently? And will he invest in renewable energy?

REPEAL 2005 ENERGY BILL. Obama opposes "a 2005 energy bill that represented the largest-ever investment in renewable sources of energy. That bill certainly wasn't perfect . . . contained irresponsible tax breaks for oil companies that I consistently opposed, and that I will repeal as president."

BY 2012, INCREASE RENEWABLE SOURCES OF ENERGY. "I'll . . . require that 10 percent of our energy comes from renewable sources by the end of my first term—more than double what we have now."

EXTEND PTC. "I'll . . . extend the Production Tax Credit [PTC] for five years to encourage the production of renewable energy like wind power, solar power, and geothermal energy."

INCREASE BIOFUELS BY 2022. Obama aims "to have 6 billion gallons of . . . fuel come from sustainable . . . biofuels, and we'll make sure that we have the infrastructure to deliver that fuel in place."

MODERNIZE NATIONAL UTILITY GRID. "[W]e will . . . need to modernize our national utility grid so that it's accommodating to new sources of power, more efficient, and more reliable. That's an investment that will also create hundreds of thousands of jobs, and one that I will make as president."

INCREASE FUEL EFFICIENCY STANDARDS. "I will increase fuel efficiency standards by 4 percent per year, lift the 60,000-per-manufacturer cap on buyer tax credits to encourage more Americans to buy ultra-efficient vehicles, and encourage automakers to make fuel-efficient hybrid vehicles."

UPDATE FUEL EFFICIENCY STANDARDS. Obama will "overhaul th[e] process for appliances and provide more resources to [the] Department of Energy so it implements regular updates for efficiency standards. [I] will also work with Congress to ensure that it continues to play a key role in improving our national efficiency codes."

FOSTER PRODUCTION OF FUEL EFFICIENT CARS. "I'll provide \$4 billion in loans and tax credits to American auto plants and manufacturers so that they can retool their factories and build these cars."

SPUR PURCHASES OF FUEL EFFICIENT CARS. "[O]ne of the things I want to do is make sure that we're providing incentives so that you can buy a fuel efficient car that's made right here in the United States of America, not in Japan or South Korea." Obama will therefore "create a New \$7,000 Tax Credit for Purchasing Advanced Vehicles."

WEATHERIZE HOMES. Obama will "make a national commitment to weatherize at least one million low-income homes each year for the next decade, which can reduce energy usage across the economy and help moderate energy prices for all."

#### SPECIFIC TARGETS

BY 2010, INCREASE WHITE HOUSE PLUG-IN VEHICLES. "Within one year of [my] becoming president, the entire White House fleet will be converted to plug-ins as security permits; and half of all cars purchased by the federal government will be plug-in hybrids or all electric by 2012."

BY 2012, ENSURE NEW BUILDINGS WILL BE 50 PERCENT MORE EF-FICIENT. "We will set a goal of making our new buildings 50 percent more efficient over the next four years. And we'll follow the lead of California and change the way utilities make money so that their profits aren't tied to how much energy we use, but how much energy we save."

BY 2013, REQUIRE ALL NEW VEHICLES BE FLEXIBLE FUEL VEHICLES. Obama will "work with Congress and auto companies to ensure that all new vehicles have FFV capability . . . by the end of my first term in office."

BY 2013, MANDATE BETTER FUEL EFFICIENCY IN FEDERAL BUILD-INGS. Within five years, Obama will "achiev[e] a 40 percent increase in efficiency in all new federal buildings" and "invest in cost-effective retrofits to achieve a 25 percent increase in efficiency of existing federal buildings."

BY 2015, HAVE 1 MILLION PLUG-IN HYBRID CARS ON THE ROAD. "These vehicles can get up to 150 miles per gallon. [I] believe we should work to ensure these cars are built here in America, instead of factories overseas."

USE IT OR LOSE IT. "[W]e should start by telling the oil companies to drill on the 68 million acres they currently have access to but haven't touched. And if they don't, we should require them to give up their leases to someone who will."

SAY YES TO LIMITED OFFSHORE DRILLING. "I believe in the need for increased oil production. We're going to have to explore new ways to get more oil, and that includes offshore drilling. It includes telling the oil companies, [which] currently have 68 million acres that they're not using, that either you use them or you lose them."

SAY NO TO ARCTIC DRILLING. "I strongly reject drilling in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge because it would irreversibly damage a protected national wildlife refuge."

PRIORITIZE ALASKA PIPELINE. "We should also tap more of our substantial natural gas reserves and work with the Canadian government to finally build the Alaska Natural Gas Pipeline, delivering clean natural gas and creating good jobs in the process." "As president, [I] will work with stakeholders to facilitate construction of the pipeline. Not only is this pipeline critical to our energy security, it will create thousands of new jobs."

How will President Obama manage our petroleum reserves?

SHUT SPECULATION LOOPHOLES. "Current loopholes in Commodity Futures Trading Commission regulations have contributed to the skyrocketing price of oil on world markets. . . . [I] will enact simple legislation to close these loopholes and increase transparency on the market to help bring oil prices down and prevent traders from unfairly lining their pockets at the expense of the American people."

LEASE NATIONAL PETROLEUM RESERVE. "Over the next five years, we should also lease more of the National Petroleum Reserve in Alaska for oil and gas production."

SELL SOME OIL FROM STRATEGIC PETROLEUM RESERVE. "We should sell 70 million barrels of oil from our Strategic Petroleum Reserve for less expensive crude, which in the past has lowered gas prices within two weeks." Our current "economic emergency . . . requires a limited, responsible swap of light oil from the Strategic Petroleum Reserve (SPR) for heavy crude oil to help bring down prices at the pump."

## **Nuclear Energy**

What role does nuclear energy play in President Obama's energy policy?

SAFELY STORE NUCLEAR ENERGY. "I think that with nuclear power, we have got to see if there are ways for us to store the radioactive material in a safe, environmentally sound way, and if we can do that and deal with some of the safety and security issues, [nuclear power] is something that we should look at."

BAN NEW NUKES. "I will not authorize the development of new nuclear weapons. And I will make the goal of eliminating nuclear weapons worldwide a central element of U.S. nuclear policy."

DON'T DUMP AT YUCCA. "I will end the notion of Yucca Mountain because it has not been based on the sort of sound science that can assure the people of Nevada that they're going to be safe. And that, I think, was a mistake."

#### Coal

How will President Obama ensure that American coal is more cleanly mined?

PRIORITIZE LOW-CARBON COAL TECHNOLOGIES. "As president, I will significantly increase the resources devoted to the commercialization and deployment of low-carbon coal technologies and use a broad range of mechanisms to commercialize clean-coal technology. I will direct my Secretary of Energy to enter into public/private partnerships to develop five 'first-of-a-kind' commercial-scale, coal-fired plants with carbon capture and sequestration." "If we are using coal in the absence of these clean technologies, then we are going to be worsening the trend of global warming, and that is something that we can't do."

### Sacrifice and Service

Will President Obama call upon ordinary Americans to help create a better, greener America?

ENCOURAGE MASS TRANSIT. "I will . . . encourage communities around the nation to design and build sustainable communities that cut energy use with walkable community designs and expanded investment in mass transit."

CREATE ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICE CORPS. "I will . . . create the 5-E (Energy Efficiency, Environmental Education and Employment) Disconnected Youth Service Corps. This program will directly engage disconnected and disadvantaged youth in energy efficiency and environmental service opportunities to strengthen their communities while also providing them with practical skills and experience in important career fields of expected high-growth employment. The program will engage private-sector employers and unions to provide apprenticeship opportunities."

LINK VETS WITH GREEN JOBS. Obama will "ensure that more of our veterans can enter the new energy economy. [I] will create a new 'Green Vet Initiative' that will have two missions: first, it will offer counseling and job placement to help veterans gain the skills to enter this rapidly growing field: second, it will work with industry partners to create career pathways and educational programs."

SACRIFICE—IT'S A GOOD THING. "Everybody's going to have to change their light bulbs. Everybody's going to have to insulate their homes. And that will be a sacrifice, but it's a sacrifice that we can meet. Over the long term, it will generate jobs and businesses and can drive our economy for many decades."

## **Green Products and Technologies**

Will President Obama help bring green products and technologies to market at reasonable prices?

INVEST IN GREEN PRODUCTS: \$1 BILLION. Obama will "establish a federal investment program to help manufacturing centers modernize and help Americans learn new skills to produce green products. This . . . grant program will allocate money to the states to identify and support local manufacturers with the most compelling plans for modernizing existing or closed manufacturing facilities to produce new, advanced clean technologies. This \$1 billion per year investment will help spur sustainable economic growth in communities across the country."

FUND GREEN TECHNOLOGIES. Obama will "increase funding for federal workforce training programs and direct these programs to incorporate green technologies training—advanced manufacturing and weatherization training—into their efforts to help Americans find and retain stable, high-paying jobs."

REINVIGORATE TAXPAYERS. "I will create a High-Performance Team of experts [that] evaluates every agency and every office based on how well they're serving the American taxpayer."

EXPECT A RETURN ON YOUR INVESTMENT. "If American taxpayers are financing this solution, you should be treated like investors. That means that Wall Street and Washington should give you every penny of your money back once this economy recovers."
